Cutter Quilted Balls

Foam balls, butter knife, cutter quilt bits - Using a sharpie bisect the ball in quarters. Casually measuring from top to bottom and taking the wedge width in account cut a rectangle of fabric inch wider and longer than space to be covered and then trim to make a somewhat football shape.
Using butter knife "tuck" fabric into the foam about 1/4 inch. If there is extra fabric just trim and tuck further. To make into ornaments add a ribbon loop to the top holding in place with a heavy straight pin.
